

20 Precious Gifts from God For You

*Every good and perfect gift is from above.
James 1:17 NIV*

When we saturate our lives with the Lord, when we obey Him and trust His Holy Word, He will literally bless us with precious gifts – simply because He loves us! This is only a short list of His gifts to each of us. Feel free to add to it; His gifts are uncountable! I recommend that, as you read each verse, you personalize it. Add your own name and change the pronouns. Know without a doubt that the Lord is speaking directly to you.

1. I am Your precious, priceless, chosen child.

*God decided in advance to adopt us into His own family by bringing us to Himself through Jesus Christ. This is what He wanted to do, and it gave Him great pleasure.
Ephesians 1:5 NLT*

*And because we are His children, God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, “Abba, Father.” Now you are no longer a slave but God’s own child. And since you are His child, God has made you His heir.
Galatians 4:6-7 NLT*

But to all who believed in Him and accepted Him, He gave the right to become children of God.
John 1:12 NLT

2. How fabulous is Your love for me.

*Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes.
Ephesians 1:4 NLT*

*No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us. And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God’s love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow, not even the powers of hell can separate us from God’s love.

*But God is so rich in mercy, and He loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, He gave us life when He raised Christ from the dead.

3. You artistically created me to be unique. Just me!

*Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous – how well I know it. You watched me as I was being formed in utter seclusion, as I was woven together in the dark of the womb. You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in Your book.

*For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago.

4. You generously provide exactly those things I need today.

*Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and He will give you everything you need.
Matthew 6:33 NLT*

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all He has done.

So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask Him.

5. Spirit of God, You have moved into my life!

If you love Me, obey My commandments. And I will ask the Father and He will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth.

When the Spirit of Truth comes, He will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on His own but will tell you what He has heard. He will tell you about the future.

But I will send you the Advocate – the Spirit of Truth. He will come to you from the Father and will testify all about Me.

6. Your blessed hope gives me wings.

I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in Him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.

8. You faithfully walk with me everywhere, always.

Be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

Jesus spoke to the people once more and said, "I am the light of the world. If you follow Me, you won't have to walk in darkness, because you will have the Light that leads to life."

For God is the one who provides the seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, He will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you. Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous.

Remember this – a farmer who plans only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves a person who gives cheerfully. And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.

I am leaving you with a gift – peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.
